JOURNALISM MAJOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION
(\$1,000 each year for up to four years)

The journalism scholarship is a \$1,000 grant (\$500.00 for fall and \$500.00 for spring semesters) given to one selected incoming student who (a) completes this form (b) declares journalism communication as a major, and (c) writes an on-the-spot news story if asked by the journalism faculty as we narrow down top grant candidates.

If you are chosen for the grant, you will be notified by phone or email before the end of January. The grant is renewable, meaning the recipient is eligible to receive the scholarship each year for up to three additional years of full-time attendance after the freshman year, based on overall grade point average (3.2 or higher), keeping journalism as your declared primary major, and continued good standing in the department (cooperativeness, ethical conduct, and collegiality with other students) as determined by the communication faculty.

The following form must be completed by hand (not typed) and turned in by January 5 (before the fall semester when you plan to attend). Include photocopies of any journalistic articles you have reported for your high school or elsewhere. Send these materials to
