PUBLIC RELATIONS MAJOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION  
(\$1,000 each year for four years)**

The public relations scholarship is a \$1,000 grant (\$500.00 for fall and \$500.00 for spring semesters) per year given to one selected incoming student who (a) completes this form and (b) declares public relations as a major.

If you are chosen for the grant, you will be notified by phone or email before the end of January. The grant is renewable, meaning the recipient is eligible to receive the scholarship each year for up to three additional years of full-time attendance after the freshman year, based on overall grade point average (3.2 or higher), public relations being your declared primary major, and continued good standing in the department (cooperativeness, ethical conduct, and collegiality with other students) as determined by the communication faculty.

The following form must be completed by hand (not typed) and turned in by January 5 (before the fall semester when you plan to attend). Include any photocopies of high school or other public relations-related work, such as yearbook copy, a flier for a special event you may have helped organize, or journalistic articles you have crafted for a school newspaper.
