Etymology: Middle English, from Old English *gOdspel* (translation of Late Latin *evangelium*),
from *gOd* (good) + *spel* (tale)

- 1 a** *often capitalized* : the message concerning Christ, the kingdom of God, and salvation
- b** *capitalized* : one of the first four New Testament books telling of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ; *also* : a similar apocryphal book
- c** : an interpretation of the Christian message <the social *gospel*>
- 2** *capitalized* : a selection from one of the New Testament Gospels

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
