5. PY 321 is a prerequisite for elective PY 411.
6. All students who claim Psychology as a major should take PY 105 the first available spring following that declaration.
7. SO 111 is strongly recommended.
8. BI 111/L is a prerequisite for PY 375.
9. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours are required for graduation.
