- Ten elective hours representing at least two departments must be chosen from the following courses: BR 331, 333,421, 433, 460; EN 331cc, 481; MI 285csl (provided it is not taken to fulfill the Core Curriculum requirements); HS 322, 361, 411; PY 341 and any approved January term course.
