5. HS 477 and HS 487 may not be taken before HS 222.
6. Eighteen hours of HS electives must be taken, eight of which must be in 300+ level courses.
7. Students must complete 12 hours in the same language to fulfill the University's foreign language requirement. Students who have studied a language in high school and wish to continue this language are encouraged to do so their freshman year if possible.
8. Students are urged to choose appropriate electives to complete a second major.
9. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken.
A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation
