**NOTES:**

1. SS 111 is required in the fall semester of the freshman year for first-time freshman only.
2. Four semesters of Greek recommended, but only GR 111 is required. Students may substitute 6 hours of another language and a cultural enrichment course for GR 121 and GR 211.
3. Nine hours from the following Advanced Biblical Literature courses must be taken: BR 441, 442, 443, 444, 445, 446, 447, and GR 421.
4. BR 331 may be substituted by one of the following Bible and religion courses: BR 333, 421, 440, or 460.
5. BR 311 does not count toward major requirements.
6. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
