

# INTERNATIONAL STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR HEALTH RECORD FORM

**NOTE TO ATHLETES:** If you are a first year or transfer student athlete participating in inter-collegiate sports at H.U., you will need to complete this health form AND also forms listed and available on the H.U. Athletic website in order to participate in sports is:

**FORM DEADLINE:** *AUGUST 1 for Fall Semester and JANUARY 1 for Spring Semester*

If an athlete: Forms need to be received **prior** to first practice. (If form will be late for any reason, please contact Margaret Pasko at: [mpasko@huntington.edu](mailto:mpasko@huntington.edu) or 260-356-4026.)

Please follow these instructions in completing the Health Record Form and check off each item after completed. Note **ALL** information must be **written in English**.

\_\_\_\_\_ Student completes the first 2 pages of health history

\_\_\_\_\_ Third page of form (**physical**) to be completed by licensed physician

\_\_\_\_\_ Immunization records on 3<sup>rd</sup> page, **MUST BE COMPLETED** with dates when vaccines were given and the following immunizations are **REQUIRED**.

\_\_\_\_\_ **DT/DTP** = Diphtheria Tetanus/Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, 5 shots total **or** a current booster shot

\_\_\_\_\_ **OPV/IPV** = Oral Polio/Inactivated Polio Vaccine – 4 doses total **or** a current booster

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tetanus Booster** – Current (effective if given in the past 7-10 years)

\_\_\_\_\_ **TB Test** (Tuberculosis Mantoux Test, used in the U.S.). Must be current this year. If you have received a BCG vaccine in your country, it can cause a false-positive Mantoux TB skin test. This is especially true if the vaccine was given after early infancy, or given several times, or given in the past 5-10 years.

▶▶ **VERY IMPORTANT NOTE:** You **must** arrive on campus with a **negative TB skin test result or proof of a negative chest x-ray**.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Meningitis Vaccine** – This is mandatory for all first time students to the university. (If unable to receive this vaccine in your country, please notify the Health Services department and this can be given after you arrive at Huntington University in that department.) \_\_\_\_\_ **\*SUGGESTED VACCINES** are the **ONLY** vaccines that are **NOT** mandatory. You may want to discuss these vaccines with your physician.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Make a copy** of your 3-page health record form to keep for yourself, before mailing. Send completed form to the Student Development office and that office **ONLY**.
