

Dayton, Ohio, March 26, 1906.

Dear Bro. Howe,

Yesterday, I partly answered your letter of the 22nd. I now answer your question as to what I think of those eastern fulminations. Probably you at Huntington see much that I do not know of, and hence can have no opinion upon. The document sent out signed by Seipel and Bessor, was very dictatorial, and seems to arrogate to King Street (now in rebellion and out of the Church) the prerogatives of the Holy See of Rome! It is now the policy of the Heitermen, to renew and increase agitation; hence Morrison's and Seipel's schemes, and propositions. Ours is quietude, which

is death to them.

I have not a word about Virginia Conference, and nothing as to Pennsylvania's action on King Street and its pastorate.

As to the circular you propose to have sent out, there was only one important emendation needed, and that was that of not calling those three rebellious bodies conferences, when in each of these conferences there are ministers and members which constitute loyal and legal conferences. Please pardon any officiousness that my yesterday's letter showed on minor points.
