

CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Reporting Disclosure - ARPA

Huntington University has received funding through the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and has awarded \$1,384,501 of the received funds to provide emergency financial aid grants to students, as mandated by the Act. The University received access to the funds from the Department of Education on May 19, 2021.

On July 9, 2021, the University notified 467 enrolled students with expected family contributions for 2021-2022 within a Pell eligible range that they would receive a \$2,000 grant from the ARPA funds. \$934,000 of the ARPA allocation was awarded to 467 students through December 31, 2021.

Notification to all students regarding the remaining funds was posted to the official COVID-19 page on the University website and in the student daily digest on July 12, 2021. The notification is located on the website at this link: https://www.huntington.edu/uploads/documents/ARPA_Emergency_Funds_7.12.21.pdf. \$450,501 in ARPA allocation was awarded to 118 students who requested assistance through an online form on the University portal webpage. Awards were made to eligible students using a rubric to measure the financial need caused by coronavirus.

All awards were made via check or application to the student account if requested by the student.

The ARPA funds received by Huntington University for emergency financial aid grants to students have been fully awarded for the intended purpose.
