AX moderated the discussion which featured members of the cast reflected on their role in the play and the director (Prof. Duffer) talked about his aims for the production.

Five of the students gave presentations: Mr. Binkoski, "The Settlers of Catan: Four Player Strategy"; Ms. Jones, "Worship Tried and True"; Ms. Krause, "International and American Students Acclimation to College: Based on Maslow,s Hierarchy of Needs";



Ms. Madison, "A Framed Play: Kyd,s The Spanish Tragedy"; and Mr. Wickersham, "Weimar Bavaria: Radicals and Reactionaries." Mr. Wickersham won a Region V scholarship and Ms. Madison was a regional runnerup.

Dr. and Mrs. Michelson and Mr. Hoobler led a national chapter workshop at the convention on "Helping Chapter Members Apply to Graduate School: Programs That Work." Ms. Jones played at the Open Mic night. We donated over 200 new books for the RIF program (the most

by any one chapter) and about 150 used children's books that were donated to an inner city school in Nashville. Ms. Wise, Mr. Stauffer, Ms. Krause, and Ms. Strawhun were part of the group that visited the school, made the presentation, and read books with the students. We also received the Star Chapter award again: we've gotten it every year since its inception in 1996 (only three other AX chapters have equaled this).

April 4, 2013: Back by popular demand was the AX/Student Senate "Are You Smarter Than a College Student?" A team of AX students took on a faculty team responding to questions written by professors from the University Core Curriculum. Up for the profs: Professors: Dr. Luke Fetters, Dr. Susan Boyer, Dr. Matthew Wright and Dr. Ruth Nalliah. For the students: Ms. Blair Caldwell, Mr. Kyle Geiss, Ms. Holly Lutton, and Mr. Aaron Lehman. Confidential sources inform us the "the event was fun for those who attended and went pretty well overall. The faculty absolutely destroyed the student team however." Ooooh!
