NOTES:

1. MI 211 and MI 242 should be taken in the freshman year.
2. Students must take one course from BR 231 or 241 and one course from 251 or 261 in addition to the introductory Bible course counted in the core.
3. Five elective hours must be selected from: MI 304, 314, 365, 376, 377, or 381.
4. BR 271 is required as a prerequisite for MI 421.
5. Students are only required to take 2 credit hours of MI 495 Internship in Ministry. If students elect to take only complete 2 credit hours of MI 495, then students will need to complete 2 hours of a 300+ level elective.
6. Students are required to have 128 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses and 3 J-Terms in at least 2 departments.
7. Students completing a BA degree are required to complete 12 hours in the same language or complete at least 6 hours in the same foreign language and up to 6 additional hours in either another foreign language or in designated cultural enrichment course.
