2. Twelve hours must be taken from EN 311, 321, 337, 374, 375, 386, 387, 431, 452, 453, 454 or DM 330.
3. Students completing a BA degree in English are required to complete 12 hours in the same language or at least six hours in the same language coupled with six hours of cultural enrichment courses to fulfill the language requirement.
4. Students are required to have 128 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses and 3 J-Terms in at least 2 departments.
