- Five elective hours must be selected from: MI 304, 314, 365, 376, 377, or 381.
- BT 271 is taken as a prerequisite for MI 421.
- This program has the potential to be combined with another BA major or various other minors.
- Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
