- 2. Students who plan to go to graduate school should take MA 151 as their core curriculum mathematics course. If a student believes that he/she will not pursue a Master's degree in Social Work (MSW), the option of another 100 level core curriculum mathematics course may be selected.
- 3. SW 395 Intercultural Immersion Experience may be taken in a different term besides January for 2-3 credit hours, but needs to be taken prior to formal acceptance into the Social Work program. The application process for formal admission into the major occurs at the end of spring semester, sophomore year.
