NOTES:

1. Must complete one course from AR 115, DM 115, MU 115, or TH 115. It is suggested that majors take TH 115.
2. Majors choose one course from TH 221, 222, or 223.
3. Students are required to take at least 3 semesters of TH 391 or TH 392.
4. Twelve hours of electives in theatre courses are required (excluding TH 391 and 392).
5. Students in the theatre (NYC) major have the opportunity to spend a semester in New York City at The King's College. Students may substitute up to 12 approved credit hours from The King's College in place of required courses in the major.
6. AR 371 (Art History I), AR 382 (Art History II), MU 341 (Music History I), and MU 342 (Music History II) are suggested as cultural enrichment courses.
7. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
