1. A double major or an extensive minor is easily arranged in the above program.
2. Nine hours must be taken from BT 331, HS 346, PL 321, 333MP, 333PL, 460, or SO 421.
3. Students must complete 12 hours in the same language or at least six hours in the same language coupled with six hours of cultural enrichment courses to fulfill the language requirement.
4. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
