NOTES:

- MI 211 and MI 242 should be taken in the freshman year.
- Students must take one course from BT 231 or 241 and one course from 251 or 261 in addition to the introductory Bible course counted in the core.
- Five elective hours must be selected from: MI 224, 304, 314, 365, 376, 377, or 381.
- BT 271 is required as a prerequisite for MI 421.
- Students are only required to take 2 credit hours of MI 495 Internship in Ministry. If students elect to take only complete 2 credit hours of MI 495, then students will need to complete 2 hours of a 300+ level elective.
- Students are required to have 128 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses and 3 J-Terms in at least 2 departments.
- Students completing a BA degree are required to complete 12 hours in the same language or complete at least 6 hours in the same foreign language and up to 6 additional hours in either another foreign language or in designated cultural enrichment course.
- Students who have taken AP exams, early-entry or dual-credit courses may be able to lighten the number of credits needed during a given semester and may even eliminate the need for summer coursework. The Registrar's Offices' evaluation of prior coursework will help students and their academic advisors plan out degree requirements.
