NOTES:

1. BI 111/L and BI 241/L are necessary and will fulfill the core natural science requirements for this major.
2. SO 111 and PY 111 are necessary and will fulfill the core social science requirement for this major.
3. MA 151 Probability and Statistics is necessary and will fulfill the core math requirement.
4. BT 333TB Theological Bioethics is necessary and will fulfill the core non-introductory Bible requirement.
5. PL 260 Ethics may be taken in place of PL 220 Introduction to Philosophy. However, PL 220 Introduction to Philosophy is recommended since students are required to take BT 333TB Theological Bioethics for their major.
6. Students must take OT 306 Service Learning in Occupational Therapy (2 hours) during J-Term of their junior year.
7. Students must complete J-Term requirements in the first three years since field work begins before J-Term ends and prohibits students taking a J-Term requirement during the senior year.
8. All "OT" courses must be taken in residence (not transferrable), and students must earn a grade of **B-** or better in all "OT" courses.
