NOTES:

1. MI 211 and MI 242 should be taken in the freshman year.
2. Students must take one course from BT 231 or 241 and one course from 251 or 261 in addition to the introductory Bible course counted in the core.
3. Five elective hours must be selected from: MI 224, 304, 314, 365, 376, 377, or 381.
4. Students are only required to take 2 credit hours of MI 495 Internship in Ministry. If students elect to take only complete 2 credit hours of MI 495, then students will need to complete 2 hours of a 300+ level elective.
5. Students are required to have 120 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses.
6. Students completing a BA degree are required to complete 12 hours in the same language or complete at least 6 hours in the same foreign language and up to 6 additional hours in either another foreign language or in designated cultural enrichment course.
7. Students who have taken AP exams, early-entry or dual-credit courses may be able to lighten the number of credits needed during a given semester and may even eliminate the need for summer coursework. The Registrar's Offices' evaluation of prior coursework will help students and their academic advisors plan out degree requirements.
