NOTES:

1. A double major or an extensive minor is easily arranged in the above program.
2. Students must take two of the following four pairs of courses for a total of 12-14 hours from AR 371 and 381, MU 341 and 342, PL 311 and 321, or TH 311 and 312.
3. Students must take two of the following three pairs of courses for a total of 12 hours from EN 311 and 321, EN 374 and 375, or EN 386 and 387.
4. Nine hours must be taken from BT 311, 320, 333, 341, CO 246, 266, HS 373, MI 264, PL 333MP, 333PT, 460, SO 421, or TH 331RP.
5. Students must complete 12 hours in the same language or at least six hours in the same language coupled with six hours of cultural enrichment courses to fulfill the language requirement.
6. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
