NOTES:

1. SO 490 may be taken in place of SO 495. Students may take SO 490/495 for 2-4 credit hours. If students take less than 4 credit hours, additional elective hours must be taken.
2. Twenty-one additional hours in sociology, which may include PY 321 and SW 236, are required.
3. Sociology majors may not count SO 141 toward the core social science requirement.
4. Students are required to have 120 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses/
5. Students completing a BA degree are required to complete 12 hours in the same language or complete at least 6 hours in the same foreign language and up to 6 additional hours in either another foreign language or in designated cultural enrichment course.
6. Students who have taken AP exams, early-entry or dual-credit courses may be able to lighten the number of credits needed during a given semester and may even eliminate the need for summer coursework. The Registrar's Offices' evaluation of prior coursework will help students and their academic advisors plan out degree requirements.
