### NOTES:

1. PY 111 and SO 111 are necessary and will fulfill the core curriculum social science requirement for this major.
2. MA 151 is a prerequisite for CJ 380 and will fulfill the core curriculum mathematics requirement.
3. Two courses must be taken from: CJ 215, 322, PS 346, 456, 466, PY 211, 215, 351, 461, SO 321, 333, and 413.
4. Students are required to have 120 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses.
5. Students completing a BA degree are required to complete 12 hours in the same language or complete at least 6 hours in the same foreign language and up to 6 additional hours in either another foreign language or in designated cultural enrichment course.
6. Students who have taken AP exams, early-entry or dual-credit courses may be able to lighten the number of credits needed during a given semester and may even eliminate the need for summer coursework. The Registrar's Offices' evaluation of prior coursework will help students and their academic advisors plan out degree requirements.
