Students may add a content concentration in economics by completing EB 212 and one additional 300 or 400-level EB course, a content concentration in psychology by completing PY 211 and six additional hours in psychology, or a content concentration in sociology by completing SO 292, 321 and three additional hours in sociology.
7. Recommended Elective: TE 233 Foundations of TESOL/ELs (3 credit hours).
