- Twenty-one additional hours in sociology, which may include PY 321 and SW 236, are required.
- Sociology majors may not count SO 141 toward the core social science requirement.
- SO 490 may be taken in place of SO 495.
- Students wishing to teach sociology in high school should complete a history teaching major with a concentration in sociology.
- Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
