### ADVISING

The advising period for Spring term will open on October 24. You must make an appointment with your academic advisor to finalize your schedule of classes. If you do not know the name of your faculty advisor, check on the portal or contact the Registrar's Office.

Before your appointment, review requirements for the core curriculum and your major or interest areas. Print a degree audit from the portal to check your progress toward your degree. Prepare a proposed schedule to discuss and confirm with your advisor. Review catalog listings for information about prerequisite courses, alternate year courses, and complete course titles and descriptions at <https://www.huntington.edu/academics/academic-catalog>.

### REGISTRATION

After your advisor approves your schedule **and your registration time opens**, you may register for classes on the portal or bring your registration to the Registrar's Office in Becker Hall (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday) to have a staff member enter your courses. See the Registration Instructions on the portal for more information.

**Overloads of more than 17 hours** are permitted only by petition. Students must submit a [petition](#) for overload before they may register for **more than 17 hours**. Students are charged overload tuition for each hour above 17 registered hours.

**Independent studies, internships, directed studies, tutorials, and job shadow experiences as well as practicums that are not on the class schedule** require special forms. It is not possible to register for these types of experiences until the appropriate form has been submitted and approved.
