### NOTES:

1. MI 211 and MI 251 should be taken in the freshman year.
2. Students must take one course from BR 231 or 241 and one course from 251 or 261 in addition to the introductory Bible course counted in the core.
3. Five elective hours must be selected from: MI 304, 314, 365, 376, 377, or 381.
4. BR 271 is taken as a prerequisite for MI 421.
5. This program has the potential to be combined with another BA major or various other minors.
6. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
