NOTES:

1. Students are strongly encouraged to complete MA 151 as the core curriculum math requirement prior to taking CO 380 and 421.
2. Six hours must be taken from: CO 322, 346, 370, 371, 381, 395 (up to 3 times), 495.
3. Outside electives should be taken in complementary areas outside the department. Students will choose 6 hours of 300- or 400-level courses approved by the department.
4. Students must make sure they meet the appropriate prerequisites before registering for any upper division courses outside the communication department.
5. Students are required to have 128 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses and 3 J-Terms in at least 2 departments.
6. Students completing a BA degree are required to complete 12 hours in the same language or complete at least 6 hours in the same foreign language and up to 6 additional hours in either another foreign language or in designated cultural enrichment course.
