### NOTES:

1. This degree program is extremely demanding. We recommend that students take as many core courses as possible during summer school in order to lessen the load during the year.
2. ED 395 should be scheduled during January Term of the junior year.
3. ED 450 may be taken in place of ED 460.
4. Piano may be the major applied area, in which case, a student must complete four semesters of applied voice.
5. Must pass the piano proficiency exam and give a 25-minute senior recital.
6. ED 362 may be taken in place of ED 364.
