### NOTES:

1. Students must take one course from BR 231 or 241 and one course from 251 or 261 in addition to the introductory Bible course counted in the core.
2. Seven credit hours are required from the following: MI 495, MU 320, 338, MU A01, A02, A03, A08, A10 or up to 2 credits of any choral or instrumental ensemble.
3. Must Pass Piano Proficiency exam prior to the Field Ministry Immersion.
4. Must Pass Guitar Proficiency exam prior to the Field Ministry Immersion.
5. Students majoring in worship leadership may also be interested in completing a minor in Bible and religion, communication studies, music or theatre arts.
6. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division Bible courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
