C1 – Not equivalent to AC241, Principles of Accounting I, effective 7-1-07.

C2 - To earn credit for EN121 and EN151, students must also pass the accompanying essay. Freshmen may take the EN121 exam and essay only in June. Upperclassmen and Professional Programs students may take it in June, September, December and March. The EN151 exam and essay may be taken in October, January, April, and July; requirements for the EN151 are considered met if students pass the American Literature or English Literature CLEP exams.

C3 - Not equivalent to CS111 and does not fulfill the general education math requirement. Students may fulfill the general education math requirement by passing this exam and then completing CS117.

C4 - Not equivalent to ED236, Educational Psychology

C5 – Not equivalent to BA351, Business Law. Students may not earn credit for both this exam and BA351, effective 1-27-03.

C6 – Not equivalent to BA252, Business Organization and Management. Students may not earn credit for both this exam and BA252, effective 1-27-03.

C7 – Not equivalent to BA281, Marketing Management. Students may not earn credit for both this exam and BA281, effective 1-27-03.

Credit for French, German and Spanish Language exams changed to a maximum of 9 hours for the higher score in late 2015.
