

COVID-19 Campus Impact Update

In light of the changes in our society and in accordance with guidance from local, state and federal health officials related to COVID-19, Huntington University has taken the following precautions to ensure the safety of our students, faculty, staff and community:

- Spring Break has been extended two days. Classes will resume on Wednesday, March 25, 2020. Classes on and after March 25 will take place in an online format. This will continue through April 10. An announcement concerning the class format for the remainder of the spring semester will be made before April 10, 2020.
- Any guests or visitors to campus will need to check in at the Huntington University Welcome Center located in the Merillat Centre for the Arts (building #15 on the [campus map](#)).
- RichLyn Library is closed to non-Huntington University audiences. Members of the general public are welcome to use our [online resources](#).
- The PLEX (Merillat Complex & Fieldhouse) is closed to non-Huntington University audiences.
