The HUB

Graduation

Graduation for the Huntington, Indiana, campus will be August 15, 2020. This date should allow us to plan an in-person celebration. More details will be coming in May but go ahead and put the date on your calendar.

For students who are planning to complete their program coursework in May, attending the graduation ceremony will be optional. We will mail diplomas to students who complete all requirements for graduation by May 16 and have no holds by June 15. The Office of the Registrar will issue transcripts with spring grades and degrees posted starting May 20. More information will come to your campus email address in the next few weeks along with ways for you to register to attend the ceremony.

Refunds

In our work to comply with state and federal requests to slow the spread of COVID-19, undergraduate and graduate, residential students were asked to move out of the residence halls for the remainder of the spring 2020 semester, if at all possible. As a result of this displacement, eligible residential students will receive a partial refund for their spring room and board fees. Commuter students who are no longer using meal plans will also receive a partial refund. This refund is a prorated amount taking into account the remaining weeks in the semester and some prepaid costs for the University. Refunds will be posted to student accounts by April 9, 2020, and will appear as a "credit" on your account and a notification email will be sent to each student.
