The governor of Indiana has extended his request for Hoosiers to stay at home until April 20. In honor of that request, we will continue to operate under our stay at home protocols. Each division has a design for how their employees will contribute during this time. Some offices will still have assigned staff who cycle through the workspaces at various times. Our outside vendors are stepping up protocols for safety. Faculty are still permitted to access their office technologies but are encouraged to follow strict social distancing policies. The approximately 30 students who have received permission to stay in campus housing for the remainder of the semester will still have access to the dining commons and other critical spaces but are encouraged to follow the same social distancing requirements.

This week, Feters Construction will begin staging the areas designated for preconstruction supplies, equipment and vehicles. The University has designated certain areas for parking and access for their employees and contractors. They have been encouraged to practice social distancing as much as possible for their work duties and have been prohibited from entering any buildings other than the HUB, which is currently offline for HU personnel, students and the public.
