

## Huntington University to Make Available \$500,000 to Assist Students with COVID-19 Disruption

The University's actions are in response to the government's issuance of emergency relief funds for students in higher education who were moved from campus-based to virtual instruction and who are eligible to receive Title IV financial aid, according to CARES Act regulations. Eligible students enrolled in campus-based programs that are now being delivered fully online will receive a need-based stipend to help with unanticipated costs due to campuses being directed to move courses online. These unplanned expenses may assist students with expenses incurred for technology support, childcare, food, transition logistics and other needs attributed to the COVID-19 educational disruption.

Next week, the University will begin issuing student checks\*, for approximately two-thirds of the funded account. Remaining funds will be reserved for eligible students, currently enrolled in campus-based programs before March 25, to apply for additional help during the summer. A form will be available for students on the University portal webpage beginning June 1 to assist in making a request during June, July or August.
