NOTES:

1. Six hours must be taken from: CO 322, 346, 370, 371, 381, 395 (up to 3 times), 495.
2. Outside electives should be taken in complementary areas outside the department. Students will choose 6 hours of 300- or 400-level courses approved by the department.
3. Students must make sure they meet the appropriate prerequisites before registering for any upper division courses outside the communication department.
4. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
