Disc Golf Course Rules & Scorecard



1. When teeing off, you may not pass the tee sign until you have released the disc.
2. Each throw counts as one stroke.
3. Each throw should be made from where the disc landed on the previous throw.
4. To complete a hole, the disc must land and remain in the basket.
5. Streets and parking lots are considered water hazards. If disc lands in one of these areas, you must take a penalty stroke and make next throw from the closest edge of hazard.
6. Sidewalks are considered to be sand traps. If disc lands on a sidewalk, you must make next throw with the opposite hand.
7. MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO AVOID HITTING ANY PERSON OR VEHICLE.
8. If disc lands on top of a building, it is considered lost and will join President Dowden's disc collection. You must take a penalty stroke and throw again from the same point.
