**FORESTER VILLAGE APPLICATION
For Fall 2017 and Spring 2018**

Applications are due in the Student Life Office on or before 5:00 PM Friday March 24, 2017.

Eligible applicants will choose their apartment on April 7th. Only one from the apartment need be present to make their selection. The order of selection is by the highest total of credits in descending order.

Here is a quick update about the housing costs for Forester Village. The normal room rate for apartments is the same rate for all dorms and apartments, which we will use for students with four students in one FV apartment. **However, if an apartment drops down to only three students, each remaining resident will be charged a 3-per semester per student rate.** If an apartment drops down to only two students in an apartment the students will be placed in the residence hall. The room rate is subject to change each year, so check in the business office to find the exact amount the additional charge would be if you go to less than four (4) students in your apartment. We need to try our best to keep the apartments at full capacity, especially as we have housing options tighten up after freshman registration. When we have students living in the apartments, many of the utilities cost the same whether or not the apartment is full. If you need assistance finding a roommate, please let the director of housing know and we can discuss possible juniors or seniors who would be eligible to move to FV; however, it is up to you to find a replacement.

ROOM DRAW INFO FOR FORESTER VILLAGE APPLICANTS

- All residents of Forester Village must have junior (**at least 58 credits**) or senior (**at least 92 credits**) and/or completed **four (4) semesters** of college by the upcoming fall semester.
- Squatters in an apartment **MUST APPLY** or forfeit their apartment. In order to claim squatter's rights, two students or individuals must be requesting the same apartment they lived in the previous semester and have a total of four residents for that apartment at the time of application.
- After squatters have taken their apartments, the remaining apartments will be given to the qualified applicants based upon their combined cumulative hours.
- The apartment must have four roommates at the beginning of the fall semester. If your group loses a roommate, you will need to replace them or you will be placed into the residence halls (see beginning paragraph).
- Those who have been confirmed to live in Forester Village should not participate in the residence hall room draw.
- You may be asked to move to a different building in order to consolidate apartment complexes. You are assigned to an apartment, but not necessarily the one you were in previously, if we need to move students for maintenance or University concerns.
- PRIME and CCCU (off campus) students** are guaranteed housing for the semester they are on campus, but housing cannot be reserved for them for the semester they are not here.
- The website https://my.huntington.edu/ICS/Students/Academic_Records/ will give you your cumulative hours or you can ask in the registrar's office in Becker Hall.

FORESTER VILLAGE INFORMATION SHEET

All applicants must sign one of these sheets and turn it in along with your application.

It is important to read the following information regarding Forester Village Apartments before applying. Huntington University strives to provide diverse residential options. It is important to note that there may be differences in living experiences between the various options. Just as there are differences in Baker living and Roush living, so there will be differences in the experience in Forester Village.

1. **All residents of Forester Village** will pay the same amount as residents living in any of the main residence halls.
2. **Cable television** will not be provided for the apartments. Residents of Forester Village must assume that cost if they desire cable service.
3. **All residents of Forester Village must be on a meal plan - A, B, or C meal plans are available.**
4. **All apartments will come furnished** with bedroom furnishings, i.e. beds, chests, and desks. Dining room furnishings will be provided; however, living room furnishings will not.
5. **All campus policies regarding resident student behavior** are in effect for residents of Forester Village. See the **Huntington University Student Handbook**. It is expected that no resident of Forester Village will house members of the opposite sex overnight. Members of the opposite sex are expected to not visit beyond 1:00 AM on Sunday through Thursday evenings and 2:00 AM on Friday and Saturday.
6. **No pets** will be allowed under any circumstances in Forester Village. The only exception to this expectation will be fish in aquariums.
7. You may lose your eligibility to live in a Forester Village apartment if community life violations are taking place within the apartment or complex. Living in a FV apartment is a privilege and requires personal discretion and community accountability.
