To love others through protecting myself

- By practicing personal hygiene by washing my hands after going to the bathroom, or after touching my face or other objects outside of my personal dwelling.

- By monitoring my physical symptoms before arriving to campus, or before departing my residential space to attend class or work.

We will maintain greater physical distance for the sake of each other's safety, but we remain committed to the relationships of our HU family.
- By staying home if I feel sick and notifying the appropriate people in the HU community.
- By remaining alert to others' needs, offering encouragement and help.
- By pursuing unity, rather than sowing discord and division.

To protect my community through my actions and attitudes

- By following HU protocols and policies, including ones that I disagree with or that inconvenience me.
- By keeping the spaces and places I frequent clean and cleaning up after myself.
- By being mindful not to take unnecessary risks related to my personal travel or entertainment.
- By remaining hopeful about our campus community and intentional in the ways that I interact with others, knowing that we serve a God who loves us and calls us to intentionally and sacrificially love each other.
