NOTES:

- Nine additional hours in philosophy are required. Sample courses are shown here, but other PL courses could be taken.
- Additional philosophy courses, BR 331, 333CCT, 333CH, 333PT, 333TB, 341, EN 374, HS 322, 342, 434, MA 205 or other courses approved by the department are required to reach 36 hours in the major.
- If you take PL 440 or PL 460 for the major, this will also fulfill your core upper level Bible requirement.
- Students are required to have 128 hours to graduate, including a minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses and 3 J-Terms in at least 2 departments.
- Students completing a BA degree are required to complete 12 hours in the same language or complete at least 6 hours in the same foreign language and up to 6 additional hours in either another foreign language or in designated cultural enrichment course.
