4. Twelve elective hours must be chosen from: Creativity (AR 141, AR 142, EN 362, EN 391, PL 333AE); Critical Thinking (HS 222, HS 261, MA 351, PY 381); Communication (BA/CO 213, CO 241, CO 246, BI/PY 375); Collaboration (BA 252, BA 311, BA 331, PL 260).
5. Students majoring in Heuristics must complete 12 hours in the same language to fulfill the language requirement.
6. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
