3. Twelve additional hours in psychology are required. Many electives in the major will be alternating year courses.
4. Those desiring to teach Psychology in secondary school should complete a teaching major in history with a concentration area in Psychology.
5. SO 111 is strongly recommended.
6. BI 111/L is a prerequisite for PY 375.
7. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
