**NOTES:**

1. PY 215 may be taken in place of PY 211.
2. Students planning to attend graduate school should take MA 151.
3. Twelve additional hours in psychology are required, which may include SW 236 and 345. Many electives in the major will be alternating year courses. PY 230 does not count towards major requirements.
4. Those desiring to teach Psychology in secondary school should complete a teaching major in history with a concentration area in Psychology.
5. SO 111 is strongly recommended.
6. BI 111/L is a prerequisite for PY 375.
7. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
