NOTES:

1. Students must take one course from BR 231 or 241 and one course from 251 or 261 in addition to the introductory Bible course counted in the core.
2. MI 211 and MI 242 should be taken in the Freshman year.
3. MI 351 Outdoor Adventure Leadership⁶ should be taken during January Term.
4. Students must take two hours in experiential recreation and sports learning from MI 295, 395, 495 or any other course approved by the department.
5. Students must take a two hour internship in a recreation or sports ministry.
6. Courses that must be completed before the Field Ministry Immersion.
7. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
