NOTES:

1. SO 111 is not required during the freshman year but is recommended in that year.

3. SO 490 may be taken in place of SO 495.
4. Twenty-one additional hours in sociology, which may include PY 321 and SW 236, are required.
5. Sociology majors may not count SO 141 toward the core social science requirement.
6. Students wishing to teach sociology in high school should complete a history teaching major with a concentration in sociology.
7. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
