4. Sociology majors may not count SO 141 toward the core social science requirement.
5. Students wishing to teach sociology in high school should complete a history teaching major with a concentration in sociology.
6. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
