**NOTES:**

1. Must complete one course from AR 115, DM 115, MU 115, or TH 115. It is suggested that majors take TH 115.
2. Two courses from TH 221, 222 or 223.
3. One course from TH 224, 316 or 431.
4. Two courses from TH 320CO, 320LI, 320SC or 320SO.
5. Students interested in Scene Design should take TH 221 and 320SC. Students interested in Lighting Design should take TH 222 and 320LI. Students interested in Costume Design should take TH 223 and 320CO.
6. Students are required to take at least 3 semesters of TH 391 or TH 392.
7. One course from TH 396, 397, 398, or 399.
8. PH 111/L and CH 111/L are suggested for the lab science.
9. AR 371(Art History I), AR 382(Art History II), MU 341 (Music History I), and MU 342 (Music History II) are suggested as cultural enrichment courses.
10. EN 431 is suggested as upper level electives.
11. Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
