

Thank you for planning your visit to Huntington University.

We are excited to meet you, show you our campus, and, most important, answer your questions. Our number one priority is preparing for our fall academic year and keeping our campus community safe. Therefore, we are currently following safety precautions for our staff and campus guests.

PRIOR TO YOUR VISIT

- Assess your health and reschedule your visit if you exhibited fever, chills, cough, muscle pains, or difficulty breathing in the past two weeks
- Limit your party to three individuals total



AT THE START OF YOUR VISIT

- Enter through the door on the far right when you arrive at the Welcome Center/Merillat Centre for the Arts – you can use your elbow to activate the automatic door switch
- If for some reason we are not there to greet you when you arrive, please wait for us at one of the three tables available in the lobby

DURING YOUR VISIT

- For your safety, staff will be wearing masks
- You may bring a mask of your own, we will provide one for you, or you may go without if you choose
- Resist the urge to shake hands (it's hard for us, too!)
- Allow us to open any doors for you
- Wash your hands or sanitize regularly – we'll be happy to point you in the right direction
- Keep appropriate social distance from anyone outside your group; we are intentionally spacing meeting rooms for your safety
