**NOTES:**

- Students must take one course from BR 231 or 241 and one course from 251 or 261 in addition to the introductory Bible course counted in the core.
- MI 331 may be taken in place of MI 221.
- BR 271 is recommended as a prerequisite for MI 373.
- Eight credit hours are required from the following: MU 112, 113, 178, 301, 302, 320, 338, MU A01, A02, A03, A08, A09, A10 or up to 2 credits of any choral or instrumental ensemble.
- Must Pass Piano Proficiency exam prior to the Field Ministry Immersion.
- Must Pass Guitar Proficiency exam prior to the Field Ministry Immersion.
- Students majoring in worship leadership may also be interested in completing a minor in Bible and religion, communication studies, music or theatre arts.
- Majors must be careful in selection of electives so that a sufficient number of upper division courses are taken. A minimum of 36 hours of 300+ courses is required for graduation.
