\* Effective 7-15-08, Prometric, owner of DSST exams, released “refreshed” versions of ten of the exams. During the revision process, the scoring method was changed to criterion-referenced standard-setting from the previous norm-referenced standard-setting. As other exams are refreshed, they will be switched to the new 500-point scale, but in the meantime, it can be confusing to see the two different types of scores.

D1 - Not equivalent to any specific HU course

D2 - Will fulfill the HU intro to fine arts core curriculum requirement (AR115, MU115 or TH115) for students in the "traditional" undergraduate program. Will fulfill the fine arts requirement for students in Professional Programs.

D3 - Considered a history elective

D4 - Similar to SO444, Crime and Delinquency. Students may not earn credit for both SO444 and this exam, effective 4-01.

D5 - Not equivalent to PL260, Ethics

D6 - Not equivalent to ED212, Introduction to Education. Non-catalog elective credit. Students may not earn credit for an Education major by passing this exam.

D7 - Not equivalent to BA431, Human Resource Management. Non-catalog elective credit. Students may not earn credit for a Business major or minor by passing this exam; nor may students earn credit for both BA431 and this exam, effective 1-27-03.

D8 - Not equivalent CS111, Introduction to Computers. Elective credit. Students may not earn credit for CS111 and also for this exam, effective 5-16-10.

D9 - Will fulfill the requirement for one of the developmental psychology courses, PY211 or PY215.

D10 - Not equivalent to EB381, Money and Banking. Non-catalog elective credit. Students may not earn credit for a Business major or minor by passing this exam; nor may students earn credit for both EB381 and this exam, effective 1-27-03.

D11 - Not equivalent to BA421, Principles of Finance. Non-catalog elective credit. Students may not earn credit for a Business major or minor by passing this exam; nor may students earn credit for both BA421 and this exam, effective 1-27-03

D12 - Not equivalent to any specific core curriculum science course, but passing would permit earning credit for one core science course. Effective 1-1-01, students using this course to satisfy one core science requirement must take biology for the other core science.

D13 - Not equivalent to CO215, Public Speaking. This exam is NOT ADMISTERED AT HU.

D14 - Not equivalent to MA151, Introduction to Probability and Statistics

D15 - Considered a business elective

D16 - Not considered a history elective. Non-catalog, elective credit.

D17 - Accepted by Professional Programs as equivalent for OM116.
